

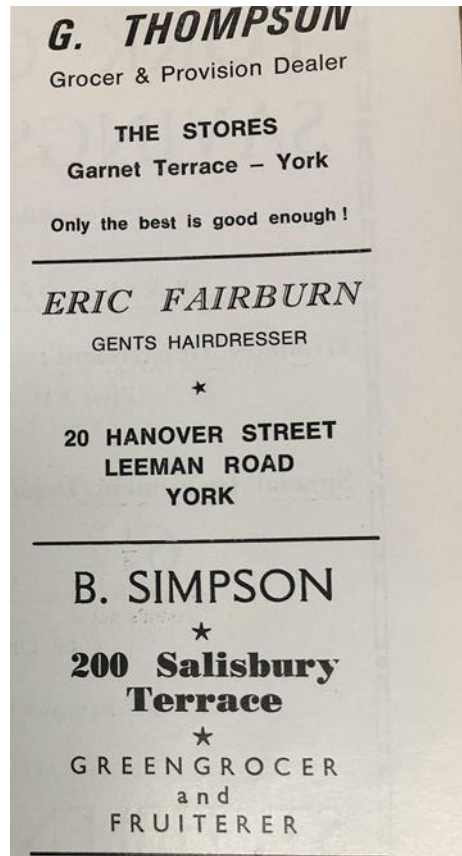
Lesson 4: How have the shops in the Leeman Road area changed?

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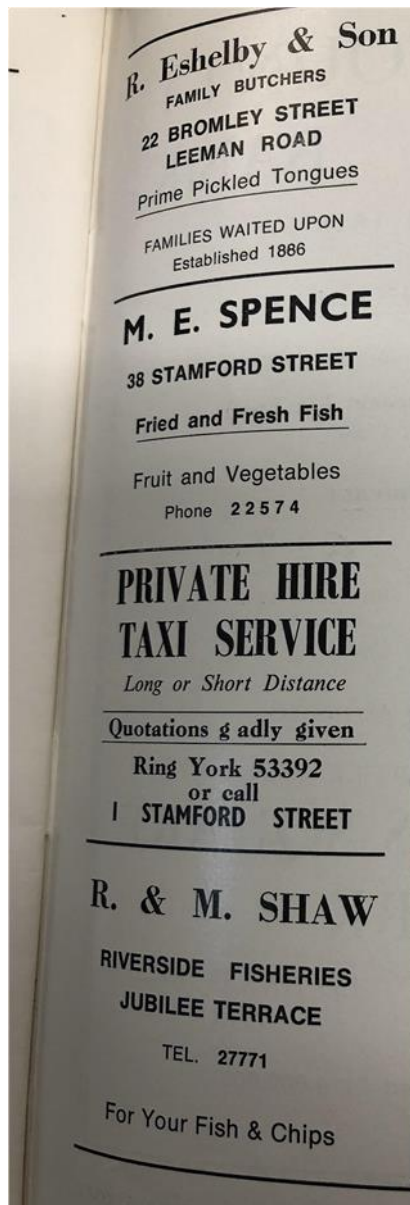
