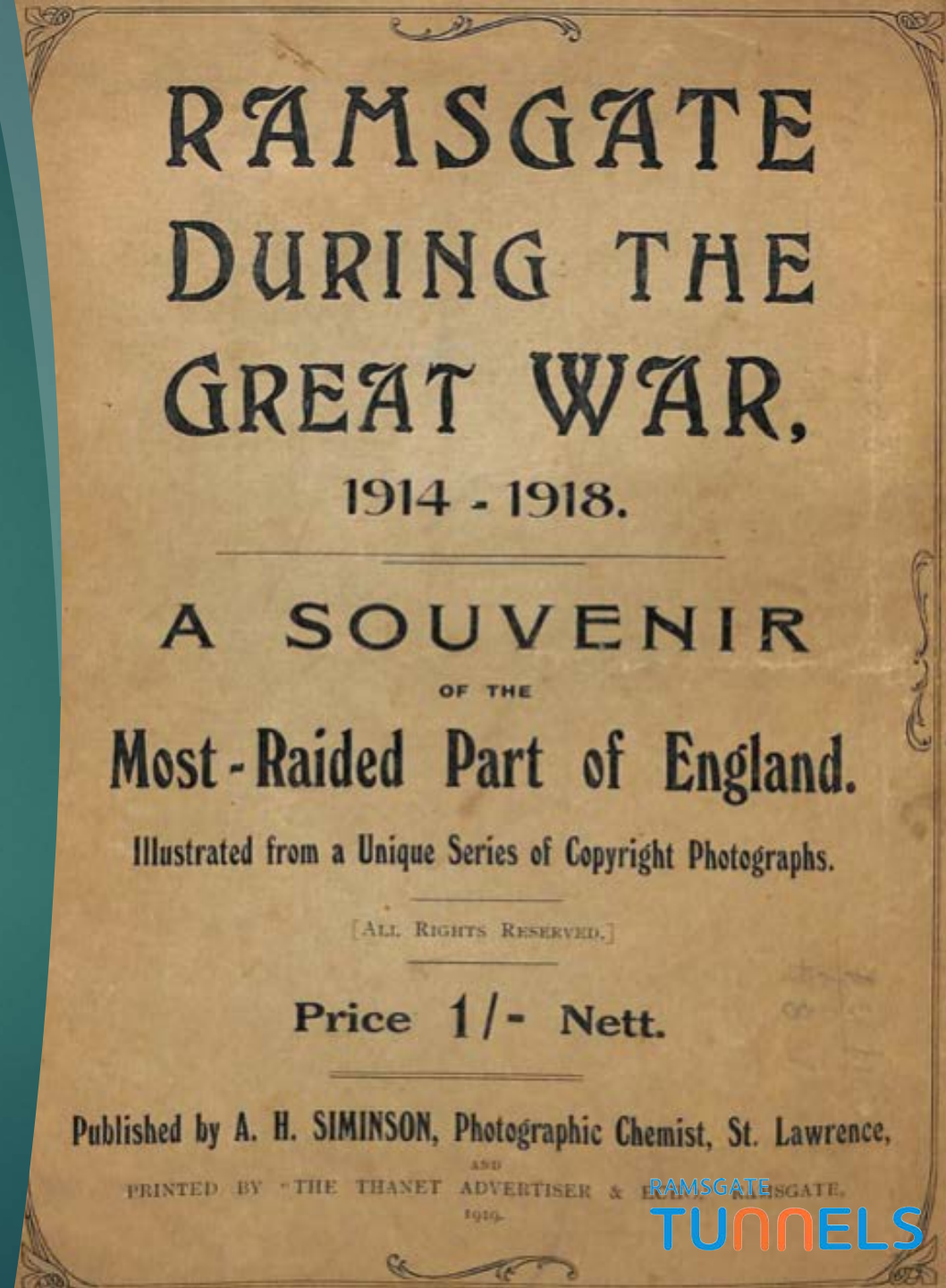
Main Victorian Railway Tunnel (Slide Two)

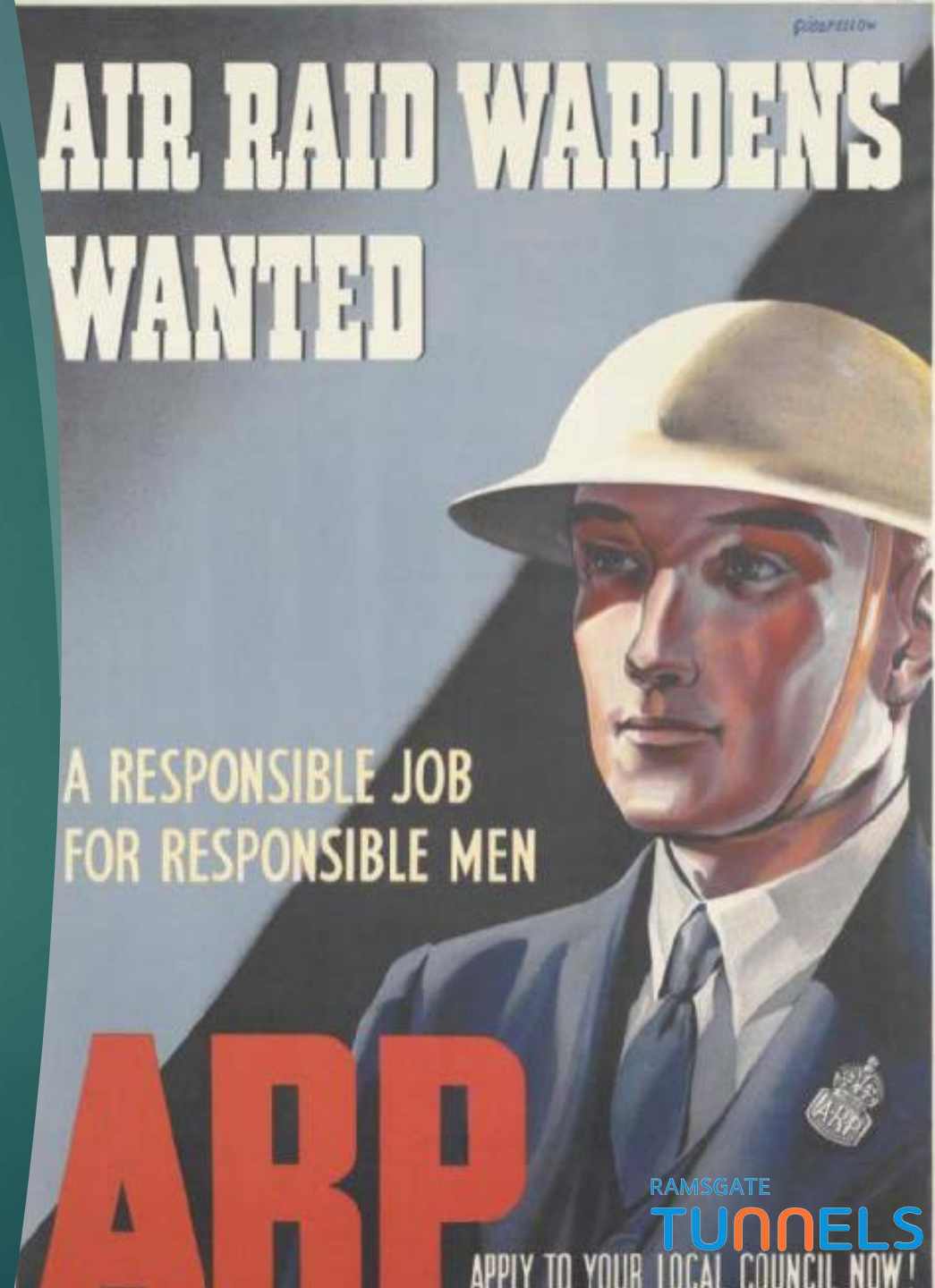

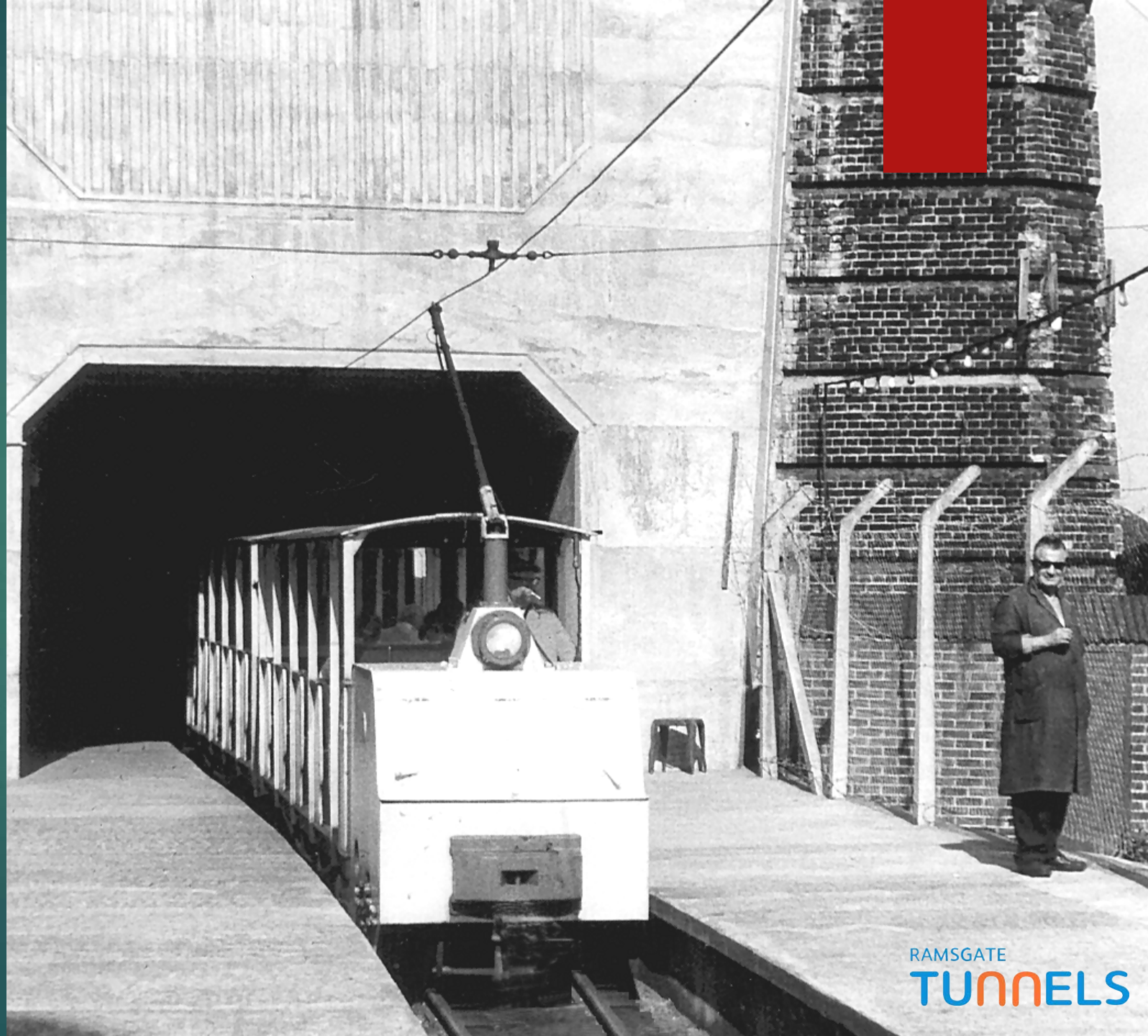
Life below ground... (Slide Seven)
